Middle and Upper School Uniform Requirements

In recognition of the connection between standards of dress and performance, and the spirit of professionalism, Oak Hall School has established requirements for school dress and personal appearance. As a school, we are committed to the value proposition of school uniforms, both from the standpoint of financial cost and for the intrinsic values of equity and unity that school uniforms bring to our learning community.

This School Uniform Guidebook sets forth the School's uniform policy, which all Middle and Upper School students must adhere to throughout the school day. Dress code violations may result in disciplinary action. Requests for deviation from the uniform policy or appearance standards should be made to the Division Director and will be decided case-by-case.

School-provided Identification Cards are considered part of the uniform. They should be worn visibly by all students daily.

ID Cards can be worn on an Oak Hall lanyard or an Oak Hall reel clip (available in Eagles Landing, our campus school store).

Uniform Bottom Options:

Dress pants, shorts, skirts, or skorts of an appropriate length. "Appropriate length" means at least fingertip length when arms are extended downward parallel to the body.

Joggers, cargo pants, and cargo shorts are not permitted.

A black or brown belt must be worn with any bottoms with belt loops.

Permitted Colors:

- Black
- Khaki
- Navy
- Lands' End Burgundy/Gray Plaid
- Lands' End Gray

Where to Purchase:

Any retail supplier of your choice. Please note: gray bottoms and plaid bottoms must be purchased from Lands' End and must be the "burgundy/gray plaid."

Examples of uniform-compliant bottoms that are available for purchase can be found at Lands' End.

Uniform Top Options:

School uniform polo and button-up shirts with the approved school Eagle or Tree logo at the chest (pictured below).

LOGOS (all polos and outerwear must have one of the approved logos from Lands' End or BSN; the only exception is the sweatshirt (see Outerwear below) which can be purchased from the school store):

Uniform polo shirts are available in long and short-sleeve options and in cotton or Dri-Fit material.

Oak Hall club, team, or athletics polo shirts or t-shirts are not uniform-compliant or permitted. They may be worn only on designated Spirit Days (generally Fridays).

Permitted Colors:

- White
- Black
- Gray
- Burgundy
- Navy

Where to Purchase:

Uniform polos and button-ups must be purchased from Lands' End or the BSN Online School Store.

A limited quantity of school uniform polo shirts with the approved tree or Eagle logo may be available for purchase at our campus school store.

Uniform Sweatshirt:

The school uniform-approved crewneck sweatshirt as pictured below:



A uniform polo must be worn under the uniform sweatshirt.

Permitted Colors:

- Gray
- Burgundy

Where to Purchase:

Uniform sweatshirts must be purchased from the on-campus School Store.

Oak Hall club, team, or athletics sweatshirts are not uniform-compliant or permitted. They may be worn only on designated Spirit Days (generally Fridays). Hooded sweatshirts of any type may not be worn at any time.

Uniform Cold Weather Outerwear:

Students may wear any non-compliant outerwear outside during inclement weather; however, non-compliant items must be removed upon entering any building on campus. The following items may be worn indoors:

Varsity letter jackets are also acceptable outerwear.

- Gray
- White
- Navy
- (as available in the style mentioned above options)

Where to Purchase:

Lands' End, BSN Online School Uniform Store, or from the on-campus School Store.

Oak Hall club, team, or athletics jackets, fleeces, or outerwear are not uniform-compliant or permitted. They may be worn only on designated Spirit Days (generally Fridays). Hooded jackets or outerwear of any type are not permitted on Spirit Day.

Shoes and Socks:	Permitted Colors:	Where to Purchase:
Shoes must be closed toe with a back. For Middle School students, running shoes or cross-training shoes with socks must be worn in PE class. Boots are not permitted. Rubber shoes are also not permitted. Socks, if worn, must be below the knee. Full-length tights or leggings in white, black, or navy may be worn underneath a uniform bottom on cold days. Headwear: Hats, caps, and beanies are not permitted. Exceptions may be made at the discretion of the Division Director.	N/A	N/A
Spirit Wear: On designated Spirit Days (generally Fridays), students may wear any Oak Hall-branded top, jersey, t-shirt, jacket, or outerwear with uniform-compliant bottoms. Hooded jackets, sweatshirts, or outerwear are not permitted. All general appearance standards apply for Spirit Days.
