At Oak Hall School, we recognize the strong connection between standards of dress, student performance, and a culture of professionalism. With this in mind, we have established uniform requirements that reflect our commitment to equity, unity, and a focused learning environment.

Uniforms offer practical benefits—including cost-effectiveness—and serve as a unifying element that reinforces our school community’s shared values.

This School Uniform Guidebook outlines the official uniform policy for all Lower, Middle, and Upper School students. Adherence to the policy is expected throughout the school day, and violations may result in disciplinary action. Any requests for exceptions to the uniform or appearance standards should be directed to the Division Director for case-by-case consideration.



LOWER SCHOOL

All students in 3-year-old Preschool through 5th grade are expected to follow the uniform guidelines outlined in this document.

The following pages include examples of approved uniform options. Uniform-compliant items can be purchased through the Lands' End website by searching for Oak Hall School in the School Uniforms section and selecting the Lower School division. A selection is also available at our on-campus school store.

Please note: there is a distinction between uniform-compliant attire (required Monday–Friday) and optional spirit wear items, which are only permitted on Fridays.



TOPS

LOWER SCHOOL (3-YEAR-OLD PRESCHOOL - 5TH GRADE)

All uniform tops must have Oak Hall School tree logo or Eagle logo.

Knit/Active Polo or Oxford Shirts:

Burgundy, soapstone, white, black, or navy long- or short-sleeved knit shirt/active dry shirt or white long or short-sleeved Oxford shirt with mandatory Oak Hall School logo (Eagle or Tree) embroidered. Only the top button may be unbuttoned. These should be purchased through Lands' End or the school store.

Nike Dri-FIT uniform shirt options are allowed in Lower School but must be purchased through BSN or the school store.



BOTTOMS

LOWER SCHOOL (3-YEAR-OLD PRESCHOOL - 5TH GRADE)

Pants or Shorts

Regulation khaki, navy, black, or gray pants or shorts. Cargo shorts are not permitted.

Skirts/Skorts/Jumpers

Regulation khaki, gray, black, navy, or plaid skirt, skort, or jumper (Lower School only).

Privacy shorts or shorts that cover undergarments are required under skirts or jumpers.



OUTERWEAR (INCLUDING SWEATERS & SWEATSHIRTS)

LOWER SCHOOL (3-YEAR-OLD PRESCHOOL - 5TH GRADE)

All outerwear tops must have Oak Hall School tree logo or Eagle logo.

Sweaters

Solid burgundy, navy, or gray embroidered v-neck sweater vest, cardigan, or long-sleeved crew neck with mandatory school logo. A uniform shirt with a collar must be worn underneath sweaters.



Sweatshirts

Oak Hall crew neck sweatshirts must be purchased through the school store. A uniform shirt with a collar must be worn underneath sweatshirts. **Hooded sweatshirts may not be worn at any time on campus.**

Outerwear

Any outerwear can be worn outside during inclement weather; however, only uniform-compliant pieces will be allowed in buildings. Non-compliant outerwear must be removed upon entering any building on campus. School uniform approved fleece jacket or 1/4-zip jacket may be worn indoors. Uniform-compliant cold weather outerwear must be purchased from Lands' End, BSN Online School Uniform Store, or from the on-campus school store. Please label all outerwear with the student's name.



BELTS, SHOES, SOCKS, ETC.

LOWER SCHOOL (3-year-old Preschool - 5TH GRADE)

Belts

If worn, regulation dark brown, navy, or black solid belt.

Ties

If worn, ties must be purchased through Lands' End or the campus school store.

Shoes

In the Lower School, athletic shoes must be worn daily.

Socks/Tights

Socks must be worn with athletic shoes and may be navy, gray, white, or black. Sock length should be ankle or mid-calf. Additionally, girls may wear white knee-high socks and solid navy, gray, white, or black tights under uniform bottoms.

Nails

Artificial or acrylic nails are not compliant with dress code guidelines.

Accessories

No earbuds, headphones, phones, or smart watches should be used during school hours in the Lower School.

Hair

Hair must be kept neat, clean, and well-groomed.

Hair color must be a naturally occurring shade. Unnatural colors such as pink, purple, blue, green, or similar tones are not permitted.

Hair accessories and styling elements should be simple and should not include metallic tinsel, glitter, or similar reflective materials that may cause distraction in the classroom. Hairstyles should not obstruct the face or interfere with participation in school activities.



MIDDLE SCHOOL

All students in 6th-8th grade are expected to follow the uniform guidelines outlined in this document.

The following pages include examples of approved uniform options. Uniform-compliant items can be purchased through the Lands' End website by searching for Oak Hall School in the School Uniforms section and selecting the Middle School division. A selection is also available at our on-campus school store.

Please note: there is a distinction between uniform-compliant attire (required Monday–Friday) and optional spirit wear items, which are only permitted on Fridays.



TOPS

MIDDLE SCHOOL (6TH-8TH GRADE)

All uniform tops must have Oak Hall School tree logo or Eagle logo.

School uniform polo and button-up shirts with the approved school Eagle or Tree logo at the chest.

Permitted Colors

- White • Black • Gray • Burgundy • Navy

Where to Purchase

Uniform polos and button-ups must be purchased from Lands' End or the BSN Online School Store. A limited quantity of school uniform polo shirts with the approved tree or Eagle logo may be available for purchase at our campus school store.

School-provided Identification Cards are considered part of the uniform. They should be worn visibly by all Middle School students daily. ID Cards can be worn on an Oak Hall lanyard or an Oak Hall reel clip (available in Eagles Landing, our campus school store).



BOTTOMS

MIDDLE SCHOOL (6TH - 8TH GRADE)

Pants, Shorts, Skirts

Dress pants, shorts, skirts, or skorts of an appropriate length. “Appropriate length” means at least fingertip length when arms are extended downward parallel to the body.

Joggers, cargo pants, compression pants, and cargo shorts are not permitted.

Permitted Colors

- Black • Khaki • Navy • White (skirts only) • Lands’ End Burgundy/Gray Plaid • Lands’ End Gray

Where to Purchase

Any retail supplier of your choice. Please note: gray bottoms and plaid bottoms must be purchased from Lands’ End and must be the “burgundy/gray plaid.” Examples of uniform-compliant bottoms that are available for purchase can be found at Lands’ End.



OUTERWEAR (INCLUDING SWEATERS & SWEATSHIRTS)

MIDDLE SCHOOL (6TH - 8TH GRADE)

All outerwear tops must have Oak Hall School tree logo or Eagle logo.

Sweaters

Solid burgundy, navy, or gray embroidered cardigan, or long-sleeved crew neck with mandatory school logo. A uniform shirt with a collar must be worn underneath sweaters.



Sweatshirts

Oak Hall crew neck sweatshirts must be purchased through the school store. A uniform shirt with a collar must be worn underneath sweatshirts. **Hooded sweatshirts may not be worn at any time on campus.**

Outerwear

Any outerwear can be worn outside during inclement weather; however, only uniform-compliant pieces will be allowed in buildings. Non-compliant outerwear must be removed upon entering any building on campus. School uniform approved fleece jacket or ¼-zip jacket may be worn indoors. Uniform-compliant cold weather outerwear must be purchased from Lands' End, BSN Online School Uniform Store, or from the on-campus school store.



BELTS, SHOES, SOCKS, ETC.

MIDDLE SCHOOL (6TH - 8TH GRADE)

Belts

If worn, regulation dark brown, navy, or black solid belt.

Ties

If worn, ties must be purchased through Lands' End or the campus school store.

Shoes

Shoes must be closed toe with a back.

For Middle School students, running shoes or cross-training shoes with socks must be worn in PE class.

“Birkenstock” style and “Ugg” style clogs, sandals, slides, or slippers are prohibited.

Thigh-high boots,

Western boots, and rubber shoes not permitted.

Socks/Tights

Socks, if worn, must be below the knee and solid white, navy, or black. Patterns are not permitted.

Full-length tights or leggings in white, black, or navy may be worn underneath a uniform bottom on cold days.

Headwear

Hats, caps, and beanies are not permitted.

Exceptions may be made at the discretion of the Division Director.

Hair

Hair must be kept neat, clean, and well-groomed.

Hair color must be a naturally occurring shade. Unnatural colors such as pink, purple, blue, green, or similar tones are not permitted.

Hair accessories and styling elements should be simple and should not include metallic tinsel, glitter, or similar reflective materials that may cause distraction in the classroom.

Hairstyles should not obstruct the face or interfere with participation in school activities.



UPPER SCHOOL

All students in 9th-12th grade are expected to follow the uniform guidelines outlined in this document.

A selection is also available at our on-campus school store.

TOPS

UPPER SCHOOL (9TH-12TH GRADE)

All uniform tops must have Oak Hall School tree logo or Eagle logo.

School uniform polo and button-up shirts with the approved school Eagle or Tree logo at the chest.

Permitted Colors

- White • Black • Gray • Burgundy • Navy

Where to Purchase

Uniform polos and button-ups must be purchased from Lands' End or the BSN Online School Store. A limited quantity of school uniform polo shirts with the approved tree or Eagle logo may be available for purchase at our campus school store.

School-provided Identification Cards are considered part of the uniform. They should be worn visibly by all Upper School students daily. ID Cards can be worn on an Oak Hall lanyard or an Oak Hall reel clip (available in Eagles Landing, our campus school store).



BOTTOMS

UPPER SCHOOL (9TH - 12TH GRADE)

Pants, Shorts, Skirts

Dress pants, shorts, skirts, or skorts of an appropriate length. “Appropriate length” means at least fingertip length when arms are extended downward parallel to the body.

Joggers, cargo pants, compression pants, and cargo shorts are not permitted.

Permitted Colors

- Black • Khaki • Navy • White (skirts only) • Lands’ End Burgundy/Gray Plaid • Lands’ End Gray

Where to Purchase

Any retail supplier of your choice. Please note: gray bottoms and plaid bottoms must be purchased from Lands’ End and must be the “burgundy/gray plaid.” Examples of uniform-compliant bottoms that are available for purchase can be found at Lands’ End.



OUTERWEAR (INCLUDING SWEATERS & SWEATSHIRTS)

UPPER SCHOOL (9TH - 12TH GRADE)

All outerwear tops must have Oak Hall School tree logo or Eagle logo.

Sweaters

Solid burgundy, navy, or gray embroidered cardigan, or long-sleeved crew neck with mandatory school logo. A uniform shirt with a collar must be worn underneath sweaters.



Sweatshirts

Oak Hall crew neck sweatshirts must be purchased through the school store. A uniform shirt with a collar must be worn underneath sweatshirts. **Hooded sweatshirts may not be worn at any time on campus.**

Outerwear

Any outerwear can be worn outside during inclement weather; however, only uniform-compliant pieces will be allowed in buildings. Non-compliant outerwear must be removed upon entering any building on campus. School uniform approved fleece jacket or ¼-zip jacket may be worn indoors. Uniform-compliant cold weather outerwear must be purchased from Lands' End, BSN Online School Uniform Store, or from the on-campus school store.

Varsity letter jackets are acceptable.



Oak Hall club, team, or athletics jackets, fleeces, or outerwear are not uniform-compliant or permitted.

They may be worn only on designated Spirit Days (generally Fridays).

BELTS, SHOES, SOCKS, ETC.

UPPER SCHOOL (9TH - 12TH GRADE)

Belts

If worn, regulation dark brown, navy, or black solid belt.

Ties

If worn, ties must be purchased through Lands' End or the campus school store.

Shoes

Must be closed-toe with a back. "Birkenstock" style and "Ugg" style clogs, sandals, slides, or slippers are prohibited.

High-high boots, Western boots, and rubber shoes not permitted.

Socks

Must be below the knee; solid white, black, or navy.

Patterned socks or tights are not permitted.

Headwear

Hats, caps, and beanies are not permitted. Exceptions may be made at the discretion of the Division Director.

Hair

Hair must be kept neat, clean, and well-groomed.

Hair color must be a naturally occurring shade. Unnatural colors such as pink, purple, blue, green, or similar tones are not permitted.

Hair accessories and styling elements should be simple and should not include metallic tinsel, glitter, or similar reflective materials that may cause distraction in the classroom. Hairstyles should not obstruct the face or interfere with participation in school activities.



SPIRITWEAR (TYPICALLY RESERVED FOR FRIDAYS)

ALL GRADES (3-year-old Preschool-12TH GRADE)

On designated Spirit Days (generally Fridays), students may wear any Oak Hall-branded top, jersey, t-shirt, jacket, or outerwear with uniform-compliant bottoms. Hooded jackets, hooded sweatshirts, or hooded outerwear are not permitted.

All general appearance standards apply for Spirit Days.
